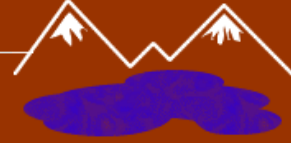

Miles for Mel Ride

As part of the week-long Sandpoint Bike Week celebration, join us in a fun early morning 68 mile bike ride to Newport (and back) to support the **Panhandle Alliance for Education**. We will escort Sandpoint resident **Mel Dick** as he embarks on an epic 10,000 + mile cross country bike ride.

WHEN: Sunday - June 1, 2008: 7:30AM

WHERE: We will meet at the Bonner County Courthouse parking lot and depart promptly at 8:00AM, the ride will get to Newport via the Long bridge and Sagle Bike Trail to Dufort Road ending at Newport Park. Food and water will be available at the finish in Newport. At your option ride back Highway 2 or Dufort Road or arrange other transportation back to Sandpoint. Limited sag support will be provided including a few rides back from Newport.

WHO: Anyone on a human powered vehicle is allowed and welcome.

WHY: Because we love riding our bikes, to get the message out about the health benefits of riding bikes, to raise funds for the Panhandle Alliance for Education and mostly to get Mel out of town.
